2. Revised Policies for WIOA

Exhibit #2: Revised policies

Action: Motion

<u>Background Information</u>: Policy Number 400-01 and 400-02 - LWC recommended the Workforce Development Board have a policy for funding out-of-parish jobseekers. After research on best practices, we settled on no more than 25% of the participants enrolled in OJT or scholarship training could reside outside Rapides Parish. Policy Number 400-03 – This is a clarification that resulted from LWC Monitoring Training. LWC identified that supportive services must be accompanied by a justification.

Policy Number 400-05 – Priority of Service – Modified policy to add that 51% of the participants must meet the criteria from the Priority of Service policy.

Policy Number 500-02 – Youth Eligibility – Modified policy to add that funding is to be for youth who are residents of Rapides Parish. However, Manager(s) may grant a funding request if youth's resident parish has no youth funds. Policy Number 800-01 – Fiscal – Modified policy to determine if a cost is allowable prior to charging WIOA for that cost.

Exhibit #3: Section 10 – Ethics Training / Financial Disclosure in Orientation Manual

<u>Background Information:</u> Commencing January 1, 2012, Pursuant to R.S. 42:1170 each "public servant" is required to receive a minimum of one hour education and training on the Code of Governmental Ethics during each year of his public employment or term of public service. Workforce Development Board members, WDB staff and all non-members on the Committees are classified as public servants or public employees.
