
### 2022 After School Program

The City of Alexandria, along with the Rapides Parish School Board, offers a free After School Program for students in grades 1-8. The program will start Sept. 19, 2022, and run until the end of the school year in May of 2023.



The program, which will be offered from 3:30-6:30 p.m. Monday-Thursday, includes homework help, tutoring, computer access and snacks for participants. Activities will be held at the Youth and Teen Center (former Boys and Girls Club building) at 1801 Sylvester Street, the Broadway Resource Center at 712 Broadway Avenue, Martin Community Center at 2301 Mill Street and the Bolton Avenue Community Center at 315 Bolton Avenue.
