What it is

The Northstar Digital Literacy Certificate program is a free self-guided online set of assessments that show your ability to perform basic computer tasks. You can earn a certificate in each of these areas:

- **Essential Computer Skills** (Basic Computer Skills, Internet Basics, Using Email, Windows, Mac OS)
- Essential Software Skills (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, Google Docs)
- Using Technology in Daily Life (Social Media, Information Literacy, Supporting K-12 Distance Learning, Care Search Skills, Your Digital Footprint)



How to use it


To get started, talk to your instructor or contact person at this site. You can also each test online by yourself at www.digitalliteracyassessment.org.

At the end of each assessment, you will receive your results. You'll get a list of the skills you've mastered and the skills you need to learn.

- Lead can seriously hurt your brain and body!

Ask you family how old your house is!



If there is flaky paint like this in your house, don't touch it! It may contain lead hazards!

you may be eligible if:

- Your home is not in a floodplain
- Your home was built before 1978
- Your income does not exceed the current HUD

Workforce

Most countries celebrate Labor Day or Worker's Day on May 1st, except for the United States and Canada.

In a phenomenon known as "karoshi," a high number of Japanese drop dead at the work desk as a result of their 60-70-hour workweek. Every year, over 10,000 Japanese suffer "karoshi."

A study showed that a majority for employees were using 50% or less of their vacation days, mostly due to the fear of falling behind in their work and becoming more stressed on their vacation than working as normal.
