

Unemployment rates drop in eight Metropolitan Statistical Areas

Data released last month by the Louisiana Workforce Commission shows that of Louisiana's nine Metropolitan Statistical Areas (MSA), eight showed a drop in their not seasonally adjusted unemployment rate from October 2022. All MSAs showed a decline from their November 2021 figures. Louisiana's not seasonally adjusted unemployment rate for November 2022 is 2.9%, a record low for the state. The figure is 0.2% lower than the October 2022 revised estimate of 3.1%, which was the prior record low. The rate is a decrease of 1.1% from the November 2021 rate of 4.0%. This shows 21 consecutive months with an over-the-year rate decline.

LSUA plans to launch Handshake with local employer partners in late January 2023, with over 4,200 activated students and immediate access to over 8,000 employers and over 50,000 jobs just in Louisiana.

Since 2020, almost 19,000 Louisiana students have registered for virtual fairs, with 118 virtual fairs attended by Louisiana students on Handshake network platform.

The LSUA and the Department of Holistic Education and Career Development are committed to providing students with the tools and resources they need to succeed in their chosen fields, and we are confident that Handshake will be an invaluable asset to achieving this goal.
