Initial unemployment insurance claims drop for week ending February 25

The initial unemployment insurance claims for the week ending February 25, 2023, dropped to 1,374 from the week ending February 18, 2023, a total of 1,576. For a comparison, during the week ending February 26, 2022, 1.327 initial claims were filed.

The four-week moving average of initial claims decreased to 1,661 from the previous week's average of 1,778.

The unemployment insurance continued claims for the week ending February 25, 2023, decreased to 11,757 from the week ending February 18, 2023, a total of 12,054. The continued claims were below the comparable figure of 13,085 for the week ending February 26, 2022. The fourweek moving average of continued claims decreased to 12,057 from the previous week's average of 12,206.

DCFS SNAP Benefits Update



With SNAP COVID extra benefits ending, here are some things you can do ...



Verify your regular SNAP benefit amount

- Check the EBT card balance through CAFE (www.dcfs.la.gov/CAFE), the LifeinCheck mobile app or by calling 1-888-LAHelp-U (1-888-524-3578)
- · Review customized letters from DCFS that contain benefit

Review your info in case you're eligible for more benefits

- Has your household size increased?
- · Are you facing higher costs for shelter, child care or court-ordered child support?
- · Has your income decreased?
- · Are you elderly or disabled with changes in your medical expenses?

Report any changes to DCFS immediately at www.dcfs.la.gov/cafe, at 1-888-LAHelp-U (1-888-524-3578) or by visiting a DCFS Office.



Consider additional means of assistance

- You may be eligible for the WIC Program, Apply at www.LouisianaWIC.org.
- · Visit your local food pantry.

February is the final month of SNAP COVID extra benefits DCFS has been issuing since March 2020. The federal spending bill passe by Congress and signed by President Biden did not fund these COVID-related benefits.
