

Initial unemployment insurance claims drop for week ending September 30

The initial unemployment insurance claims for the week ending September 30, 2023, dropped to 1,566 from the week ending September 23, 2023, a total of 1,770. For a comparison, during the week ending October 1, 2022, 1,445 initial claims were filed.

The four-week moving average of initial claims increased to 1,588 from the previous week's average of 1,552. The unemployment insurance continued claims for the week ending September 30, 2023, increased to 12,764 from the week ending September 23, 2023, a total of 12,729. The continued claims were above the comparable figure of 10,320 for the week ending October 1, 2022.

The four-week moving average of continued claims decreased to 12,940 from the previous week's average of 13,163.




The Chamber's Women In Business Conference is one of the most dynamic, engaging, and exciting events in the central Louisiana region.

Lead Safe Housing Program

The City of Alexandria Community Development Department is offering to inspect and remove deteriorated lead paint from homes at no cost through the Lead Safe Housing Program.

Applications are accepted Monday - Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 4:00 pm at 625 Murray St., Suite 7. Alexandria, LA. The Lead Hazard Reduction Grant program is available to home owners and rental property owners who meet the qualification criteria. Those who qualify may receive grants of up to \$14,000 for repairs designed to control lead-based paint hazards. This includes FREE interior/exterior paint, replacing old wooden windows with new vinyl windows, and aluminum trim.

To qualify for the Lead Hazard Reduction Grant program, a homeowner or renter must meet the following criteria:

- Housing was built before 1978 and is located within Alexandria city limits
- Owner-occupied units must have one of the following:
 - a child under the age of 6 who resides in the unit, or
 - a child under the age of 6 who spends a "significant amount of time" in the unit, or
 - a pregnant woman who resides in the unit
- Rental units do not require a qualifying child occupant at the time of assistance. The landlord must agree to give priority to families with children under the age of 6 when renting for 3 years following the completion of lead abatement activities. Vacant Rental units are eligible for assistance as well.
- Total household income must be below 80% of Area Median Income.
