Mr. Michiels began by introducing the guest in attendance.

Mr. Michiels continued with the agenda starting with Old Business.

- Reports:
 - o Briefly reviewed the goals and objectives from the last LEPC "Kick Off" meeting held on December 5th, 2023.
 - Provided the Committee with a Tier II/ Treasury Report advising the committee of the number of facilities within the Parish that have been reported to the local LEPC and number that still need to report to the local LEPC.
 - Reported to the Committee on the number of Reportable Incidents and Courtesy Notifications/Releases as reported by LSP Right to know and
- Mr. Michiels recognized Sr. Tech James Rougeou of LSP he gave the committee a demonstration/ PowerPoint about the LEPC, and when it was created. He showed several slides explaining the LEPC, the threshold for Facilities and how/when incidents should be reported.

Discussion was held after the presentation and questions were asked/ answered by various Committee

Members and guests.

- Mr. Michiels recognized Mr. Doug Cramer from the NWS as a guest speaker. Mr Cramer presented to the Committee several slides from NWS with how predictions are made about hurricanes, the upcoming season, and the new weather App called Slack and how it works with local agencies.
 - Discussion was held and several Committee Members and guests asked him questions regarding the upcoming Hurricane Season.
- Mrs. Michele Keys with Hexion was recognized. She gave a brief overview of the Table Top
 exercise that was conducted at their plant where parish officials and first responders were
 invited and included on December 7, 2023. She highlighted strategic points and a few of
 their take aways.
- The next item was ESF 10 portion of the Parish Emergency Operations Plan. Each committee member had been provided a copy prior to todays meeting. Discussion was held and the changes that were agreed upon will be made, then a final version provided to all Committee Members.

Motion made by Greg Timberlake and seconded by Patricia White to approve the updated ESF 10 – Haz Mat Plan, with changes/corrections noted. On vote, motion carried.

• Mr. Randy Anthony with Boardwalk Pipelines was recognized and called on to review the upcoming Mock Drill that they are hosting on 5/14/2024. During his overview of their company he also welcomed other agencies/responders interested in testing their response capabilities to reach out to him so that it can all be coordinated, if feasible.

The Chairman thanked Boardwalk for providing the Working Lunch and invited everyone to enjoy the meal while the meeting continued.

There was no other Old Business, so Chairman Michiels moved on to New Business:

- Motion made by Patricia White and seconded by Sherry Ledington nominating Greg Timberlake as the Committee Vice-Chair. There being no other nominations, vote was taken and all in favor, Greg accepted. Motion carried
